OPERATION SMART- INNOVATION PROGRAM

Girls will participate in local and national STEM & STEAM novel engineering and design challenges, they will be introduced to a variety of STEM careers including, web development, ecology, and game design. Girls will develop their critical thinking skills using engineering techniques daily. Students will showcase their design projects at the end of summer showcase.



OPERATION SMART- TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

Girls will become digital citizens by learning how to use computer hardware, software, and internet applications. Students will showcase their websites at the end of summer showcase.



GIRLS INC. MEDIA LITERACY

Communications 101: Girls will investigate and analyze media-related careers and learn marketing strategies. Students will end the summer creating their first Girls Inc. student newsletter.



ECONOMIC LITERACY

Business 101: Girls will learn how to start a business using a business model canvas. Students will end the session with an elevator pitch competition



GIRLS INC. LITERACY

MIND & BODY
